- To establish and maintain such departments and institutions as may be necessary for the propagation of the Gospel and the work of this Pentecostal fellowship.

- To approve scriptural teachings and practices, and to disapprove unscriptural teachings and practices as set forth in Article IX and X of the Bylaws.

- To have the right to own, hold in trust, use, sell, convey, mortgage, lease, or otherwise dispose of such property as may be needed.
