

**Tyson Coughlin** became a Christian at age 13 while reading the Bible. A year later, he began preaching in a nursing home in his home state of West Virginia – it was just the right audience (gracious and captive) for a young man beginning to share the Gospel. As a young

preacher, Tyson went from nursing homes and hospitals to churches and college campuses

proclaiming the Good News to anyone who would listen.



At age 18, Tyson received a basketball scholarship to West Virginia Wesleyan College. He played only one year before deciding to turn in the scholarship for Bible College. In 2006, he left his home in the mountains to move halfway across the country to attend a small Bible College in Alexandria, Louisiana. It was there he felt the call to plant a vibrant, world-changing church in Charlotte, North Carolina.

In 2010 Tyson and his team began a college ministry called C4 Charlotte. It started as a small Bible study and within 2 years became one of the largest student organizations at the University of North Carolina Charlotte. C4 was reaching 300+ college students each weekend. Many young people made decisions for Christ and were baptized.


In the Fall of 2012, Tyson and his team planted Vizion Church in the heart of Uptown Charlotte. Vizion Church is now 7 years old and God has done extraordinary things in the church's infancy. Over 200 people have given their lives to Christ, and the church now reaches 117 nations through the Vizion Church YouTube Channel and podcast.

**Rick Dubose** was elected Assistant General Superintendent of the Assemblies of God at the 58th General Council in August 2019. He is a member of the Executive Leadership Team.

Prior to his current position, he served as General Treasurer of the Assemblies of God from 2017-19. He served as Superintendent of the North Texas District from 2007-17 and Assistant District Superintendent from 2005-07. DuBose pastored Sachse Assembly of God in North Dallas from 1987-2005. Prior to that, he served a pastorate in Hallsville, Texas, and began his ministry as a youth minister in Mesquite, Texas.

**Joe Gordon** serves as the Eurasia Regional Director for Assemblies of God World Missions. He oversees ministries in 44 nations within seven distinct areas. Through the influence of Assemblies of God missionaries, he and Laurie both spent a summer in Eurasia and felt

called to a ministry in the region. The couple married in 1992. After graduating in 1993, they began their life as mis-

sionaries in Eurasia.



Joe and Laurie's passion has always been planting the church where it does not exist. They worked on the ground planting churches in unreached areas and partnered with the National Church to start three Bible Schools to train workers for church-planting efforts. Additionally, they spent six years in Southeast Asia pioneering in a restricted access country.

The 44 countries and territories of Eurasia are home to more than 4,400 unreached people groups. Only 1.5 percent of Eurasia's 2.4 billion inhabitants are evangelical Christians. The Gordon's are passionate about Eurasia's Big Dream, a vision to realize a church-planting movement among every people group in Eurasia.
